From the Pastor's Desk

"God helps those who help themselves." "Everything happens for a reason." "Love the sinner, hate the sin." You may have learned these phrases from your parents, grandparents,

pastors, or Sunday School teachers. Many people think these phrases are in the Bible, or are, at least, based on the Bible.

Pastor Adam Hamilton wrote a book titled "Half Truths: God Helps Those Who Helps Themselves and Other Things the Bible Doesn't Say." I'll be kicking off my fall sermon and Bible study series on September 8th guided by the Bible passages that are in Pastor Hamilton's book.

Sometimes we go on "auto-pilot" about the Bible and church. Bible studies like this one, about "Half Truths" are not just about upending assumptions we may have had about a quote or two that (we thought) are from the Bible.

A lot of us actually live our lives as if our Christian faith guides us to "love the sinner, hate the sin" and a lot of us really believe that "God helps those who help themselves." We speak, act, and understand based on what we think these phrases mean. We give their messages authority when and if we think they are based in Scripture. *Continued on Page 2...*

Faith on "auto-pilot" might be comfortable, but does it guide us ethically? Faith on "auto-pilot" might be deeply rooted and grounded in our families and our backgrounds, but does it help us to see from the perspective of another person?

Jesus asked his disciples not only to have sympathy for others, but to have *empathy*. The difference is that being *empathetic* means that you consider what it's like to walk in another person's shoes. Many of the "Half Truths" that this Bible study will explore stretch us toward more empathy, and therefore, more faithful discipleship.

I hope you'll join me Sunday mornings at 10:45 a.m. in the Education Center Room 4/5 for Bible study. I look forward to learning with you!
